



Use Your SNAP & HIP Benefits at MetroWest Farmers Markets

To find HIP-eligible food, visit www.mass.gov/hip, call Project Bread's Hotline at 1-800-645-8333, or look for the HIP logo at local markets.

The Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) provides families with monthly help to buy healthy foods. If you receive SNAP benefits, **you are automatically enrolled in the MA Healthy Incentives Program (HIP).**



HIP puts the SNAP dollars you spend on local fruits and vegetables back on your EBT card instantly. **You can get \$1 back on your EBT card for every \$1 spent on fruits and vegetables at the Farmers' Market!** Once the money has been put back on your EBT card, you can spend it at any SNAP retailer like always.

\$40 for 1-2 people

\$60 for 3-5 people

\$80 for 6+ people

HIP Eligible Foods

Any fruits and vegetables sold by HIP vendors are eligible!
